Sherriff's Report

Deputy Evanoff stated that if there was one area that the speed limit could be lowered in the Township, it would be Elson and East Sparta Ave due to the multiple houses and turns on the road. The speed limit is reduced in Sandy Township to 40.

Also, Howenstine from Cleveland Ave to the Southern Crossing and to Martin Dr., he feels that it should be lowered to 45mph because of the frequency of homes.
