Regular Meeting

1st Public Speaks Session

Rob Kimble received a letter from the Township about multiple complaints about the dust that is coming out of Kimble on Cleveland Ave. He stated that they don't want to make trouble for the Township, thus they ordered oil for their road, and should be putting it on next week.

Nancy Snyder gave an update about the newly purchased Melscheimer school and said it is moving along nicely.

Grooms thanked the road Crew for patching South Maplehurst. He also stated that Johnnie Miller is not in the best of health, and hopes everyone will pray for him and send him a card.

Bob Fonte, from Stark Parks, gave an update on the Frye property that has been donated to them so they can put a park on the property. He would appreciate that the Trustees pass a motion of support for them to get funding from the Landfill fine monies to use on behalf of the property.

Linda Zaleski discussed some changes to the zoning resolution, especially definitions and other guideline changes. She went over the various changes in summary.

Financial Report

Knox discussed the certificate of estimated property tax revenue, from the County Auditor, that the Board requested. This was for the .5 mil fire levy that is coming due. The estimated property taxes are as follows:

1. Renewal - \$16,116
2. Replacement - \$38,884
